

Georgia International Horse Park



The Georgia International Horse Park – SPG was commissioned in 1990 to identify the development of a 1,100 site. Throughout the study, discussions were held with various civic leaders who indicated a strong need for more recreational facilities within Rockdale County. The City of Conyers and Rockdale County decided to jointly proceed with the planning of a multi-use recreational project for the site.

During 1991, Conyers and Rockdale County proposed to the Atlanta Committee for the Olympics Games to host the 1996 Olympic Equestrian Events at the proposed Georgia International Horse Park. It was felt that the Olympic Equestrian Events would enhance the future success of the Park long after the 1996 Games.
